HINTS TO Homemakers

Attitudes Caught, Not Taught — You—as a housewife and a leader of rural women—have a responsibility. First, to yourself, and then to your family, and then to your community. Here are some ways in which you can help.

FOR YOU — Adopt a positive attitude that says "Accidents can be prevented". Become "safety alert" so that you recognize hazards and know safe practices. Practice safe habits.

For Your Family — Be the safety "engineer" for your family. Guard against over-fatigue and emotional tension in your family.

Teach your family to recognize hazards.

Teach your family to practice safe habits.

Look for and remove hazards from your home.

Look for and remove hazards from your farm.

Learn how to live safely with hazards that cannot be removed.

For Your Community — Cooperate with existing safety organizations.

Use safety movies, skits and discussions as program material.

Study specific problems such as stairways, poisons, farm machinery, etc.

Use safety as the theme for exhibits and displays.

Make a study of accidents happening in your community.

Conduct "hazard hunts" in member's homes.

Encourage youth groups to conduct safety programs such as "Lite-Farm Equipment," hazard hunts, and demonstrations.

Encourage publicity on positive programs as well as accidents.

Take action on community-wide safety projects such as clean-up and fire prevention campaigns, driver education programs, or prevention of seasonal accidents like swimming, hunting, etc.

BUFFET SUPPER SALAD

You can perk up listless appetites with rice and chicken buffet salad. This one has a delicate flavor, a crunchy texture. Serve it with finger sandwiches and ice cream for a refreshing hot-weather meal.

2 cups cold cooked rice
1/2 cup minced celery
1 1/2 cups diced cooked chicken
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper
1/2 cup mayonnaise

1 No. 1 can green asparagus spears
8 hard-cooked eggs, sliced
Combine rice, celery, chicken, salt, pepper, and mayonnaise. Toss lightly. Chill.
Chill and drain asparagus.
Arrange asparagus spears on lettuce in individual salad bowls. Put a scoop of salad on top. Garnish with hard-cooked eggs.
Serve with additional mayonnaise, if desired. Yields six servings.
