




Mr. Crawford, a chief electrician's mate and veteran of 16 years' Navy service, is serving with airborne early warning squadron at the Barber's Point Naval Air Sta tion, Oahu, T. H.

Before being transferred to the Pacific, the Crawfords were sta-tioned at Brunswick, Ga., at a navy blimp base.

Since Christmas, Mrs. Crawford and Sandra have been staying with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Frank Hyatt, of Savanna, in Jackson County, and Mr. Crawford's parents, the Rev. and Mrs. Lee Crawford, Franklin, Route 4. Mrs. Crawford is the former Miss Myrtle Hyatt.
