State College Answers Timely Farm Questions

Q. What can I get to control spider mites on cotton?
A. Sulfur dusts used to do a good job but two of the most common species have apparently developed some immunity. Recent tests with new chemicals have done excellent jobs of controlling them, however. One application of half a pound of Trithion, or one pound of Ethion per acre controlled the mites better in the tests than three applications of the best dusts available previously. If you have spray equipment, one application of Demeton spray may also be effective.

Q. How can I get rid of bagworms in my shrubbery?
A. Where practical it is advisable to remove and burn the cocoons. Chemical treatments are Apply sprays of lead arsenate, malathion, or toxaphene as soon as an infestation is noted and again seven to 10 days later. Bagworms feed mostly on evergreens. They may also attack apple, elm, maple, sycamore, oak, locust, or willow trees. Early treatment is important. By the time actual feeding is usually noted the pests have developed to a stage where they are difficult to control with chemicals.

Q. How high should I cut fescue lawn grass in the summer?
A. If cut close and frequently it will thin out rapidly. Set the mower about three inches high. Closer, frequent clipping will kill it.

RALEIGH—All told, traffic accidents in the Tar Heel State claimed 1,063 victims during 1957, according to a special study by the Motor Vehicles Department. The 1957 tally was four per cent below comparable figures for the preceding year. Injuries also showed a drop, the study revealed. Injured in highway mishaps were 19,602 persons, a two per cent decrease from 1956. Reported during the year was a total of 47,705 vehicle mishaps.
