OFFICIAL SAYS HERE —
Rotary Clubs Are Uniting To Promote World Peace

Rotary clubs in 110 countries and geographical regions throughout the world are united in an endeavor to promote international understanding, good will, and peace.
That was the message of Gordon L. Butler, of Andrews, governor of district 767 of Rotary International, in addressing the Franklin Rotary Club last Thursday night following a conference with local Rotary officers and committee chairman.
In addition to the activities of the more than 9,800 Rotary clubs within their own communities to promote this objective, Mr. Butler explained, Rotary International has awarded grants of more than \$2,600,000 in the past 11 years through its program of student fellowships, which enable outstanding college graduates to study for one year in countries other than their own, as Rotary ambassadors of good will. Since 1947, when this program was established, 1,076 Rotary Foundation Fellowships have been awarded to students in 65 countries for study in 43 countries.
"With fellowship and service to others as its keynote, Rotary provides a common ground for 482,500 business and professional executives throughout the world, regardless of differing nationalities or languages or political and religious beliefs," the Rotary district governor emphasized.
"In addition to the promotion of international understanding," Mr. Butler continued, "special emphasis is being placed by Rotary clubs in this district, which includes 38 Rotary clubs in the Piedmont and Mountain area of North Carolina, on the individual Rotarian's part in helping to carry out International Rotary president Clifford A. Randall's theme, "Helping to Shape the Future". He also encouraged each Rotarian to put forth a greater effort to make his community a better place in which to live, work, and rear our children.
Mr. Butler urged the local Rotarians to attend the Rotary district conference to be held in Asheville in February 19 and 20, 1959, and to make plans for the club to be well represented at the 50th annual convention of Rotary International, which will be held in New York City next June.
