



2 cups chopped ripe tomato 2 cups chopped green tomato 2 cups chopped cucumber

1 teaspoon celery seed ½ cup sugar 1 tablespoon salt 2 teaspoons dry mustard 1½ cups vinegar Wash and drain vegetables. Scald, core, and peel ripe tomatoes

Core but do not peel green tomatocs. Cut blossom and stem ends from peppers; discard seed. Peel onion. Chop vegetables and squeeze to remove juice—saves cooking time. Mix all ingredients and cook until the liquid part is about as thick as Chili Sauce. Taste and add more seasoning if desired. Watch it!
