Sealed proposals will be received by the Mayor and Board of Commissioners at Vass, North Carolina, until 11 o'clock a. m. on the 12th day of June, 1928, at the office of the Mayor at which time all proposals will be publicly opened and read for furnishing materials, labor, tools, and equipment to complete such contracts as may be entered into for the construction of Water Supply Improvements, consisting of the following complete in place:

All bids must be placed in a sealed envelope and endorsed on the outside "PROPOSAL FOR WATER SUPPLY IMPROVEMENTS." The Town prefers to let the entire work in one contract, but reserves the right to waive technicalities and let the work in parts to separate bidders, or let such parts of the work as is considered to the best interest of the Town, and reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

Contractors are cautioned to examine the plans and specifications thoroughly, form of contract, bond and conditions under which the work will be done before bidding. In accordance with Act passed by the North Carolina General Assembly, and ratified March 10, 1925, it will be necessary for all contractors to show evidence that they are licensed to do business as such in the State of North Carolina.
