Different Varieties, Custom of Life and Travel Habits Described

The mosquito season is here again, and in some communities the public may desire to have freedom from this pest. In considering the problem of eradication and control of mosquitoes, we must fully realize that we may have several kinds of mospuitoes in one locality, and that these different varieties may differ decidedly in customs of life and travel habits.

Along the seacoast, from Maine to Texas, we have a mosquito called "Aedes Sollicitans" that breeds in brackish water, and which travels long distances voluntarily with light breezes. This species emerges in large numbers from time to time and becomes very annoying. Also, in recent years, with the development of oil fields and gas wells, inland sources of salt water under pressure have been released and the water has been brought to the surface, and this former coastal mosquito has established itself in several inland localities where it formerly did not exist.

In villages, towns, and cities we have local mosquito nuisance problems for which we ourselves are largely responsible. 
