Spencer Tracy, Lana Turner and Ingrid Bergman, a potent combination of stars in one of the most exciting and suspenseful stories in all English literature, Robert Louis Stevenson's "Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde," is the attraction at Pinehurst, Sunday night, August 31, at 8:30 (DST) and at Southern Pines Monday and Tuesday, September 1 and 2 at 8:20. Victor Fleming's production of this story is a master screen work and a first-calibre dramatic hit. Magnificent are the performances of both Spencer and Ingrid Bergman. The picture will undoubtedly be an Academy Award nomination for Spencer Tracy—his characterization of this role tops anything which has been seen on the screen; and Ingrid Bergman, so recently seen in the re-issue of "Intermezzo" is truly outstanding. The feature is 127 minutes long and will be preceded only by the News It is suggested that patrons be on time.

Dr. Kildare and his preceptor, the crusty Dr. Gillespie, go through one of their most dramatic adventures in "Dr. Kildare's Wedding Day," newest of the Dr. Kildare series, coming to Southern Pines, Wednesday and Thursday, September 3 and 4 at 8:20 p. m. (DST), with Lew Ayres, Lionel Barrymore, Laraine Day and, as special guest star, Nils Asther. The story deals with a famous symphony conductor who discovers he is growing deaf, and the work of the two doctors in restoring his musical perception. In the dramatic climax this symphony is played by a great orchestra, with Asther conducting. The music is from the Symphony composed by Barrymore, "Tableau Russe," which has been played by many American Symphony Orchestras. Barrymore also plays parts of his own music on the piano.

An attraction so startlingly new, with such an original idea and one which has been so deftly written and so well directed that wherever entertainment of unusual provocative character is sought, "Here Comes Mr. Jordan," the attraction at Southern Pines, Friday and Saturday, September 5, 6, with a Saturday matinee, is certain to be one of the most widely discussed and popular of the 1940-41 season.
