Big Policies
Six persons in the United States who died last year left over \$1,000,000 life insurance, according to a special survey of the National Underwriter, insurance newspaper. The largest claim paid by life insurance companies in 1943 was slightly less than \$2,000,000. There were four claims paid between \$800,000 and \$1,000,000; 21 between \$500,000 and \$800,000; 41 between \$300,000 and \$500,000; 68 between \$200,000 and \$300,000; 251 between \$100,000 and \$200,000; 732 between \$50,000 and \$100,000, and 1,057 between \$30,000 and \$50,000.

Bite at Night

Grain Corn
