Mirth melody and madness form the piquant ingredients for Samuel Goldsmith's new Technicolor comedy extravaganza with music, "The Kid From Brooklyn", starring Danny Kaye in the role of a milkman who turns pugilist and wins the world's championship. Coming to the Carolina Theatre, Southern Pines, Sunday, Monday and Tuesday, Sept. 8-9-10 at 8:15, with a Tuesday matinee at 3:00, the cast includes Virginia Mayo, Vera-Allen and the Goldwyn Girls who take care of the glamour and melody with several tuneful numbers, while others in the big cast include Walter Abel, Eve Arden, Steve Cochran, Fay Bainter and Lionel Stander.

Samuel Goldwyn has rung the bell again—but good this time, with a whiz of a show of the wholly escapist, entirely eye-filling and completely satisfying-to-the-appetite-for-laugh variety.

Drake's leading lady is Donna Reed, and the large cast consists of Edward Everett Horton, Spring Byington, Sig Ruman, Harry Davenport, Bill Phillips, Margaret Hamilton, Hobart Cavanaugh, Warner Anderson, Connie Gilchrist and Jack Overman.

The dramatic and moving story of how a Texas cattleman found a way into the hearts of wayward boys inspired the well-known screen writer William Ludwig with an idea for one of his most absorbing and realistic motion picture scripts. The story is unfolded in "Boy's Ranch," featuring Jackie "Butch" Jenkins, James Craig and Skippy Homeier, and coming to the Carolina Theatre, Southern Pines, Friday and Saturday, Sept. 13-14, at 8:15 p. m. with a Saturday matinee at 3:00.
