In accordance with a long estab- lished custom, the club will serve Thanksgiving dinner from noon until 4 p. m. As Thanksgiv- ing falls on Thursday, the after- noon dinner will replace the buf- fet supper at the Club next Thursday.

Xmas Funds Are Spent To Stop Tuberculosis

Christmas Seal funds are spent primarily for preventive and control measures rather than for the actual care of the tuberculous.

The latter is beyond the means of private agencies.

If all the 1945 Christmas Seal money—\$15,500,000—were spent in caring for the 500,000 persons in this country estimated to have active tuberculosis, the money would cover approximately one week's care for each patient. The average length of stay in a tu- berculosis hospital is six months.
