Judge McKeithen Honored By Duke Law Alumni Asso.

Pinehurst Man To Preside Next Week At Sanford Term

The Duke University Law Alumni Association Friday night paid honor to a distinguished member of the faculty of the Duke Law School at Durham, Prof. Malcolm McDermott, and to its own outgoing president Superior Court Judge W. A. Leland McKeithen of Pinehurst.

Prof. McDermott retires this month after 24 years at Duke.

A portrait of Prof. McDermott, made possible by law alumni subscriptions and painted by Joe Wallace King of Winston-Salem was presented to the University by Leon Rice of Winston-Salem and accepted by Duke President Hollis Edens.

Judge McKeithen, Duke alumnus of the Class of 1936 who presided at the annual meeting of the Law Alumni Association, was made an honorary member of the Order of the Coif, national scholastic honorary society for lawyers.

The association elected G. E. Miller of Asheboro, also of the Class of '36, to succeed Judge McKeithen as president, and named Rice the new vice president. Prof. E. C. Bryson was re-elected secretary-treasurer.

Judge McKeithen was elected to a one-year term on the association's council.

Of interest to friends of Judge McKeithen in this area is the fact that he will preside at a term of Lee County Superior Court, for trial of civil cases, in Sanford next week. The term opens Monday and will be the first term at which Judge McKeithen, appointed several months ago, will preside in this area.

Williams Aces In Senior Tourney At Roaring Gap

The highlight of a successful 36-hole tournament held by the Southern Seniors Golf Association over the links of the Roaring Gap Golf and Country Club June 5 and 6 was the hole-in-one scored on the par 3, 13th hole by Chester I. Williams of Pinehurst, executive secretary of the Association. Williams used a No. 5 iron to hole out his tee shot with a fairly strong breeze blowing directly toward the tee. This is the first hole in one for Secretary Williams and the second scored in tournament play in 24 years of the Association's history.

Fifty-six players competed in the Roaring Gap affair and when all the shooting was over, Frank B. Edwards of Spartanburg, 1953 champion of the Association, was the winner with two fine rounds of 72-74-146, over the sporty par-72 mountain course. Dr. C. D. Nofsinger of Roanoke, Va., won the low net prize with his two rounds of 68 for 132.

Jack F. Carter of Southern Pines, playing in the Junior Division, was right behind Frank Edwards with 147 and Fred E. Reuning of Bristol, Va., trailed Carter by one stroke with 148.

A banquet was held at the Graystone Inn Saturday night, presided over by Association President William J. Yates of Charlotte. All members and their wives were introduced and the winners in the blind bogey tournament held Saturday were awarded their prizes. The opinion of most members present at Roaring Gap was that it was one of the best tournaments held by the Association in some time and all voted to return next year.

The next tournament on the schedule for this year will be held at the famous Dunes Golf and Beach Club in Myrtle Beach, S. C., Saturday and Sunday, June 19 and 20. A fine field is expected to play, says Secretary Williams.

1,700 Cadets To Receive Training At Fort Bragg

Seventeen hundred Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) cadets—one tenth of the total number scheduled to receive training in the United States—will begin to arrive at Fort Bragg June 19.

North Carolina colleges sending units here include North Carolina State, Davidson, and A & T College.

Colleges from Maine to Puerto Rico will also send future Army officers for the annual six week summer training session. While at Fort Bragg the ROTC cadets will have an opportunity to observe operations of 82nd Airborne Division of World War 11 fame.

Major General Joseph P. Cleland, Commanding General of Fort Bragg and the XVIII Airborne Corps, has been named Camp Commander for the training period with Colonel R. E. Middlebrooks, presently Professor of Military Science at North Carolina State, in direct charge of detailed camp operation.

During the six week course this summer, the ROTC cadets will receive pay of \$78 monthly in addition to food, housing, uniforms and medical care.

While at Fort Bragg the cadets will fire individual weapons and conduct various field problems. They will receive instructions in leading small units in combat, map reading, tactical training of the individual soldier and other subjects designed to qualify them as officers.

Successful completion of the training course is a requirement for commissioning of the cadets

as second lieutenants in the Army Reserve. Not all cadets who will receive their reserve commissions will be called to active duty, however.
