Deane Inspects U. S. Housing On French Bases

Rep. C. B. Deane of Rockingham, 8th District Congressman, left Friday of last week for France where he will inspect American military housing conditions of American personnel.

Deane is a member of the House Banking and Currency Committee, which handled the Wherry Act providing for military housing construction during the 82nd Congress.

Before leaving, he said: "For several years, I have been interested in military housing overseas. In view of this interest, I have pushed housing agencies of our defense department to expedite the handling of the housing shortage for our military personnel stationed at overseas bases, especially in France and North Africa.

"Some weeks ago I appeared before the House Armed Services Committee in support of a bill which I introduced in this Congress to provide for more adequate housing accommodations for our overseas military personnel and received the commendations of the committee for my statement."

The North Carolinian said he is "becoming increasingly alarmed over the high rate of divorces and other tragic family conditions that are developing among our military personnel abroad."

"This adverse condition likewise concerns a deterrent to our effectiveness abroad. In view of my continued interests and the interest of the defense department in this question of adequate military housing overseas for our armed forces, I have been given an opportunity to go by MATS (Military Air Transport Service) tomorrow to France and will have the chance there to check several American military bases with the view of making a clearer determination of family housing conditions for our personnel stationed in France and other nearby countries," Deane continued.

He said he possibly also will visit bases in West Germany. He plans to return around the first of September.
