In all there were 1,031 death-dealing accidents, according to a study by the State Department of Motor Vehicles. It was cloudy when 146 fatal accidents occurred, raining or snowing at 90, and foggy at 17 others. Weather conditions weren't stated when 13 other fatal crashes occurred.

**Demonstration of
U. S. Air Power**

Mayor Voit Gilmore and several other business and civic leaders from this area flew to Eglin Air Force Base in Florida Tuesday to witness an aerial fire power demonstration staged there by the Air Force. The local man returned home Tuesday night. Tom Davis of Winston-Salem, president of Piedmont Air Lines, was Mr. Gilmore's guest for the trip.

Southern Pines, Fayetteville and Sanford were represented in the group that left Pope AFB, Fort Bragg, Tuesday morning, flying to Donaldson AFB, S. C., where they transferred to a C-124 Globemaster to complete the trip to the Air Proving Ground at Eglin AFB.

According to information from the Air Force, the demonstration was held in conjunction with joint civilian orientation conferences being conducted at Eglin AFB and other military installations this week, as a forerunner to Armed Forces Week, May 13-19.

Senators, Congressmen and Defense Department officials attended the demonstration, Mr. Gilmore said after his return. Bombing, strafing and flight demonstrations of the Air Force's newest and best aircraft were included in the program.

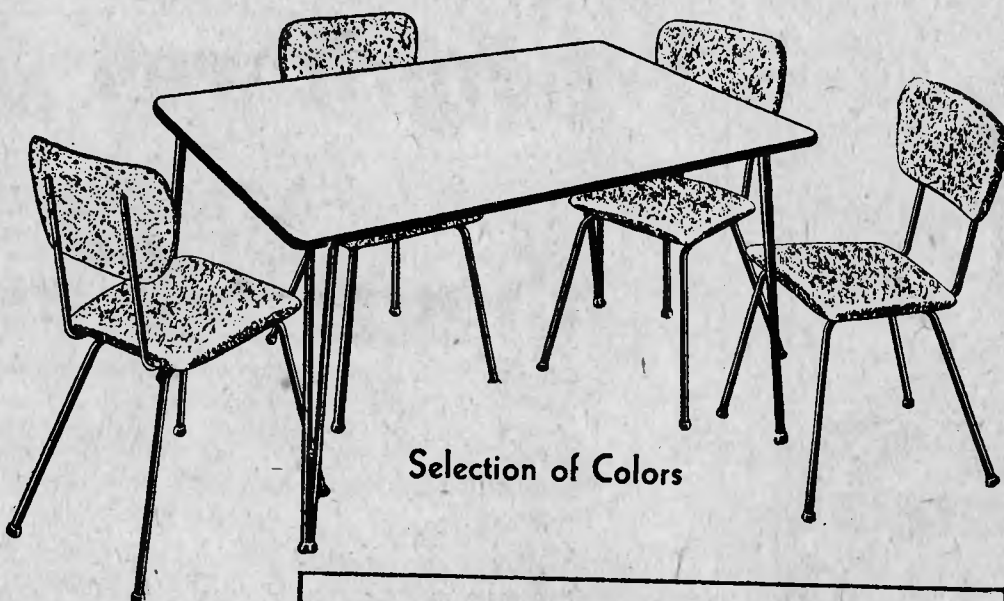
