

Younts Describes Radio's Special Events Coverage

The influential role of radio news coverage, with emphasis on special events, was discussed by Jack Younts, president and general manager of WEEB, at the regular Rotary Club meeting Friday.

The talk was made in observance of National Radio Week, being held throughout the country.

Younts, also president of the 900-n. National Daytime Broadcast Association, told the Rotary Club that radio, even in the days of television's rapid expansion, serves a vital function in the everyday lives of Americans. He demonstrated the "spot" coverage that radio provides with three different tape-recorded broadcasts.

One, the first on-the-spot coverage of an international event with radio was the special broadcast H. V. Kaltenborn made of the famous meeting between Adolph Hitler and Prime Minister Chamberlain of Great Britain at Munich.

Another, more close to home, was a vivid description of the crash of a flying boxcar in March, 1954, at Pope Air Force Base in which there was only one survivor.

Younts, with the use of special remote equipment parked outside the Country Club, also ran a tape recording of a broadcast made by one of his staff members during Hurricane Hazel.

A cartoon film describing radio growth and its potential, was shown to the club members at the conclusion of the talk.

Younts gave credit to Congressman C. B. Deane of the 8th District for obtaining hearings before the Federal Communications Commission to get more regular daily broadcasting schedules rather than the present sunrise to sunset schedule which he said caused constant conflict.

Guests at the meeting were Bill Brown of Troy and Bob Cooke of The Bronx, N. Y.
