More fatal traffic accidents occurred on Saturday than on any other day of the week during 1955, the State Department of Motor Vehicles reports. Official records reveal that 248 deathdealing accidents occurred on Saturday with Sunday in second place with 208. One hundred and three death crashes occurred on Monday, 93 on Tuesday, 101 on Wednesday, 110 on Thursday, and 167 on Friday. The 1031 fatal accidents during the year led to funerals for 1165 persons, 238 of whom were pedestrians.
