**Ed Cox Publishes  
Scientific Study  
Of Premonitions**

A theoretical study of foreknowledge was published this week, in the quarterly Journal of the American Society for Psychological Research, by W. E. Cox, Jr., of Southern Pines.

Entitled "Precognition: An Analysis," it represents an effort, extending over several years, to determine some of the lesser-known characteristics of man's occasional experiences in supernormally glimpsing or dreaming of future happenings.

The paper is in two sections, the first of which was published in April. Several spontaneous experiences are given, including one contributed by Mr. Wade Stevick of Southern Pines.

Cox said that in the section just published, detailed evidence is shown which suggests the existence of an unconscious but semi-continuous application of precognition in daily life. He bases this on findings gathered from a relative passenger-population study involving railroad accidents in the United States and Canada during 1950-54. Cox added that this is the first time that "subliminal precognition," as he calls it, has been statistically indicated through field data.

Cox, long a student of psychological research, is an associate of the A. S. P. R., and also is active in the work of the Parapsychology Laboratory at Duke University.

**Power Failure Is  
Caused By Gusty  
Winds Here Sunday**

A power failure that lasted in one section of Southern Pines for almost two hours Sunday night was caused by gusty winds that tangled a power line with a guy wire, it was reported Monday by Carolina Power and Light Company officials.

Ward Hill, who is division manager of the power company, said an interruption came in the Lakeview, Vass, Cameron and Southern Pines area at 7:20 Sunday night. Considerable search, he said, finally pinpointed the trouble at a location near the Fairway Motor Court. Relocation of some lines in that area had become necessary, he said, when the new bypass was cut through.

He said a primary line had been wrapped around a span guy wire by the wind. Such a thing is rare, he pointed out, and not something that emergency crews usually look for when a power failure is noted.

After the trouble was found and that part of the line closed off, a switch got out of alignment, causing further delay in power restoration.

Hill said that full power was back on shortly after 9 p. m.

**Vass Officer Is  
'Most Northern'  
In US Air Force**

The Air Force has announced that Robert D. Hardy formerly of Vass, who has the distinction of being the "most northern Air Force officer in America," was recently promoted to First Lieutenant.

The promotion was effective June 9.

Lt. Hardy, whose wife and children, Cheryl and Stephen, live at the Ark Apartments in Southern Pines, is currently serving as commander of the Air Force installation at Point Barrow, Alaska. He recently was the officer in charge of installing a radio broadcast station to serve personnel on duty with the arctic coast Distant Early Warning (DEW) line.

Lt. Hardy served from January to May as Special Project Officer for the Air Force in Kodiak, Alaska.

He expects to return to this country in October.
