Joel Q. Stutts, supervisor of the Southern Pines water system and sewage treatment plant, is attending a special "Sewage and Industrial Waste Treatment School" at Duke University this week. The school, sponsored by the North Carolina State Board of

Health and the N. C. Sewage and Industrial Waste Association, is one of several conducted each year to acquaint municipal employees with newest methods in the field, and assist them in learning methods of doing their jobs more efficiently.

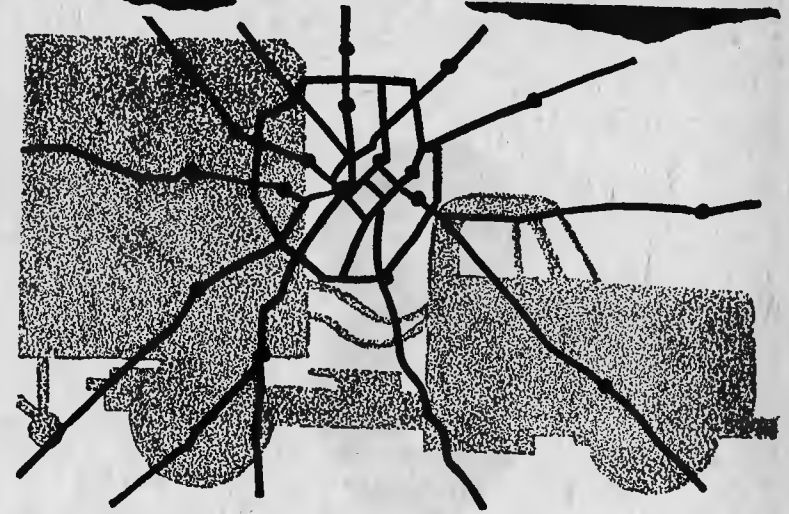

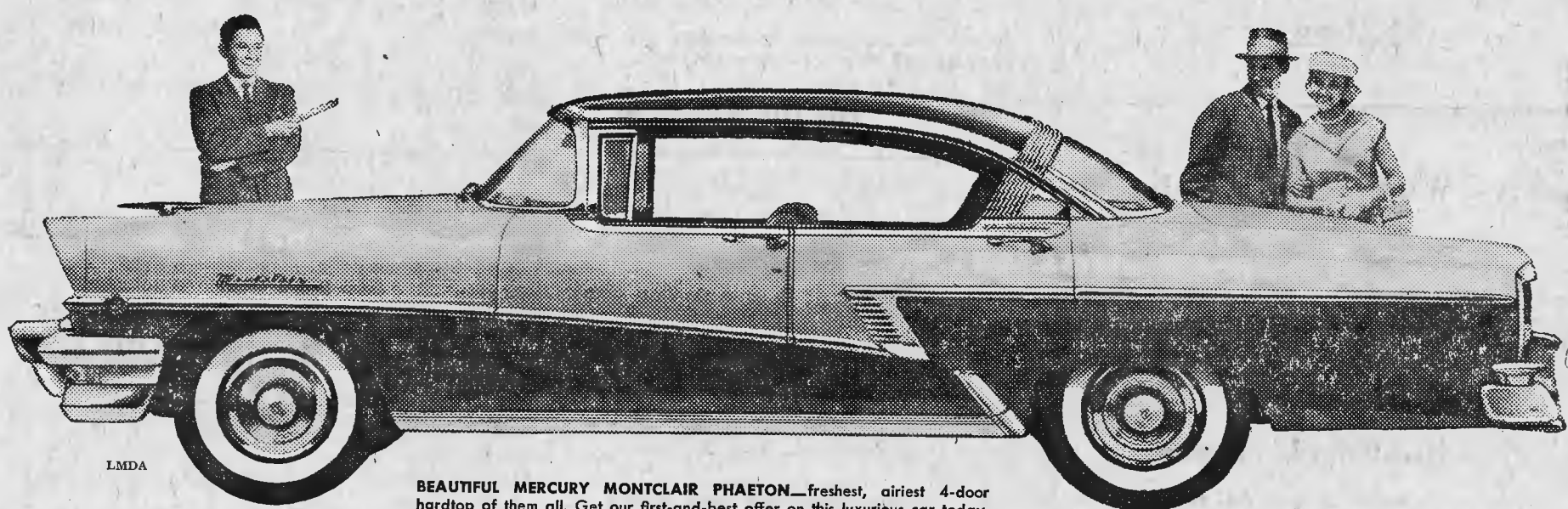
