

Thomas Supports Pearsall School Plan Amendments

H. Lee Thomas, superintendent of the Moore County school system, has announced his support of the Pearsall school plan. In commenting on the plan Mr. Thomas said, "I favor the proposed Constitutional Amendment and Implementing Acts relating to public education adopted by the 1956 extra session of the General Assembly.

"If it is adopted at the polls on September 8, desegregation of our public schools can proceed orderly and systematically. On the other hand, if the proposal fails to be adopted, there will result much strife, confusion and bitterness which could destroy support for the schools."

Presbyterian Men Plan Fall Rally At Camp Monroe

The annual Fall Rally of the Men of the Church of Fayetteville Presbytery will be held at Camp Monroe in Scotland County Wednesday night, September 12, with Dr. W. T. Thompson of Richmond, Va., as guest speaker, according to an announcement by Jerome B. Clark, Jr., of Fayetteville, program chairman for the occasion.

Dr. Thompson, who is moderator of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in the United States, will speak on "Christian Family Life." Since 1920 he has been Professor of Christian Education and Lecturer in Pastoral Theology at Union Theological Seminary in Richmond, and is one of the most sought-after speakers in the Southern Presbyterian church.

R. D. McMillan, Jr., of Red Springs, President of the Fayetteville Presbytery Men of the Church is urging each of the 96 churches in the presbytery to have a good delegation in attendance to join in the rally and hear Dr. Thompson.

The rally is being held in conjunction with the fall meeting of Fayetteville Presbytery which will convene at Camp Monroe on the next morning, Thursday, September 13 at 9:30 a. m. Many of the delegates to Presbytery attending the Men of the Church Rally are expected to spend the night and be on hand for the Presbytery meeting the next day.

A. L. Burney of Southern Pines, chairman of District Six, Men of the Church, is working hard to have every one of the 10 Presbyterian churches in his district well represented at the meeting.
