Sealed proposals will be received by the Town Manager and Town Council of the Town of Southern Pines, N. C., until 2:00 p.m. EST, Monday, October 15, 1956, at the town hall for the construction of Curb and Gutter Extensions consisting of the following approximate quantities:

- 3833 lin. ft. Concrete Curb and Gutter
- 325 lin. ft. 24" Concrete Storm Sewer
- 351 lin. ft. 15" Concrete Storm Sewer
- 5 Catch Basins

Each bid must be accompanied by a cash deposit, a certified check drawn on a bank authorized to do business in North Carolina, or a bidder's bond, for five percent (5%) of the bid, made payable to the Town of Southern Pines, N. C., as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into a contract within ten days after notification of award of the contract and that required bond will be executed.

If a bona fide bid is submitted and plans and specifications are returned, this deposit will be returned. C., at the office of the Town Manager in Southern Pines, and in the offices of the Associated General Contractors in Charlotte, Raleigh and Greensboro, N. C.

tract and upon payment in full to all persons supplying labor and furnishing materials for and in connection with the construction of the project.
