

### Four Assigned To Staff At AGOS

Three airmen, two of them from Seawart Air Force Base, Tenn., have been assigned to the USAF Air-Ground Operations School here recently. Staff sergeant Wallace Wyant of Roanoke, Va., and Airman 1c James C. Bailey of Jackson, Miss., were assigned as clerks in the billing section; and Airman 1c Wade P. Dowdy, of Fort Springs, W. Va., was assigned as a clerk in the adjutant section. Sgt. Wyant, a veteran of service in the Pacific Theatre during World War 2, has also seen service in France. He came here from Donaldson Air Force Base in Greenville.

Airman Dowdy has served 10 months in Korea since enlisting in 1951. Airman Bailey has served in Japan and Texas since enlisting in 1952.

In another assignment at the school it was announced that Airman 1c Nelson W. Slaughter, a native of Nashville, Tenn., had been attached to the transportation section. He enlisted in 1952 and has served six months with the Northeast Air Command.

### William Burroughs Resigns Amerotron Controller's Job

William H. Burroughs, controller of Amerotron Corporation for the past three years, has resigned effective December 1, company officials have announced.

Mr. Burroughs, who makes his home in Pinehurst, said he is retiring from active business life to devote his time to "travelling, playing a bit more golf and seeing more of my family."

An active member of Sandhill civic life, Mr. Burroughs has recently headed up a successful fund drive for Boy Scouts in this area. He is an active member of the Sandhill Kiwanis Club and the Pinehurst Country Club.

He is a member of the Moore County Business Development Committee and has been largely responsible for assembling and evaluating data about the county for a brochure that will be published soon.

He expects to remain at Amerotron during the transition period.

Succeeding him will be R. A. Austin of New York, who has been the assistant controller in charge of Amerotron's New York operations. Joe Sandlin, who has also been an assistant controller at Aberdeen, will continue in his same position. The operations of the division will be more spread between the two offices.

Chester J. Terrill, another of the Amerotron Corporation, has resigned his position, effective December 1. Mr. Terrill, who lives in Southern Pines, has been active in St. Anthony's Catholic Church as president of the Laymen's Association and as chairman of a Boy Scout troop at the church.

Prior to coming to Southern Pines in June 1955, he was with Amerotron in Anderson, S. C., and earlier with Textron in Providence, R. I.

Burroughs was vice-president and secretary of Reeves Brothers Textile Company for six years prior to his joining Amerotron. Before that he was secretary-treasurer of Burlington Mills International Corporation in charge of the financial end of the company's foreign operation, and assistant treasurer of the parent company, Burlington Mills Corporation.

For 10 years he also had headed up the accounting end of the domestic operation of Burlington Mills.

A native of Greensboro, Mr. Burroughs recently completed a home at Pinehurst, where he is retiring to. He owns a lodge-motel in St. Petersburg, Florida, which he will also be able to devote more time to, though he has no plans to actively manage it.

According to the Flue-Cured Tobacco Cooperative Stabilization Corporation, total flue-cured supply is now estimated at 3,588 million pounds, a record high that represents 2.9 years' usings based on current rate of disappearance. Supplies are normally balanced at about 2 1/2 years' disappearance and with domestic consumption going down as it has for the past three years, it became more important that production be brought in line before the supply situation becomes over-burdening.
