Two Youths Arrested For Robbing Woman Storekeeper At Knife Point

Two teenagers have waived a preliminary hearing to Superior Court on a charge of armed robbery. The robbery occurred on December 18, in the late afternoon at Putnam, a small settlement about 12 miles north of Carthage. A man entered the store operated by Mrs. Martha Stutts and wanted to make a small purchase, but said she would have to give him change from a \$10 bill. As she picked up the money box, he took the knife used for cutting cheese and demanded the money. He then joined a companion waiting in the car and fled. It was about 40 minutes after the crime was committed when it was first reported to the sheriff's office. According to Sheriff C. J. McDonald two weeks of intensive work was culminated by the arrest of Darrell Leroy White, 18, Cameron, and Bobby Britt, 18, Carthage.

Piedmont Airlines Officials Learn About New-Type Engine In England

Two officials of Piedmont Airlines, which serves Southern Pines with three flights daily, have recently returned from England where they received intensive training in the operation and maintenance of the Rolls-Royce Dart engine and its total propeller. The Dart engine, a new concept in air flight, will supply the power for Piedmont's fleet of 12 new Fairchild F-27 turbo-prop airplanes, the first of which is expected to be in service late this year. The new planes, according to the manufacturer, will have a cruising speed of some 280 miles per hour, 100 miles per hour faster than the present planes used by Piedmont. They will also seat 40 passengers as against the 24 that are now accommodated aboard Piedmont's planes. The information and training received by the two officials—Howard Cartwright, superintendent of maintenance, and John Rehder, director of maintenance training—will be included in a company-wide program of instruction for maintenance and flight personnel. The more than 200 maintenance personnel will receive 105 hours of technical classroom instruction on the new-

type engine, Rehder said. Both men said they were amazed at the simplicity of operation and design of the new engine. "It's so simple that I just can't see how it would ever give any trouble or stop running," Cartwright said. The engine isn't the only part of the F-27 which has been under study by Piedmont officials. The airframe has also been under scrutiny and several Piedmont pilots and company officers, including Thomas H. Davis, president, H. K. Saunders, vice-president, and captains Don Reiger and Milton Browning, have been to Holland to fly the prototype plane. Officials of the company have said the new type plane could land easily at the Southern Pines-Pinehurst airport, which has runways in excess of 5,000 feet. There had been some talk that the new type planes, which has caused the industry to start thinking about re-aligning some schedules, would necessitate cutting off service in this area, but unofficial word is that the service will continue as usual. Piedmont operates here during the fall, winter and spring. In the summer months the crew here is moved to Myrtle Beach.
