**CARTHAGE GIRLS ALSO WIN**

**Aberdeen Defeats Blue Knights For County Basketball Laurels**

Talk of constructing a consolidated high school for Southern Pines, Aberdeen and Pinehurst must have special appeal for Southern Pines coaches: twice during this school year the Red Devils of Aberdeen have beaten the Blue Knights for championship, first in football, and now in basketball.

"If you can't beat 'em, join 'em," is the old saying.

Leading 26-23 at the half Saturday night in the finals of the annual Moore County basketball championship, the Blue Knights wound up on the short end of a 58-54 score. Thirty points by center Roger Verhooff, easily the most outstanding individual effort in the game, wasn't enough. The Red Devils bore in and, behind the exacting shooting of Smith and Harvey White, dominated the second half and lost to Carthage, 55-52.

Aberdeen missed its chance of sweeping the tournament when the girls, leading at the half by two points, 30-28, fell behind in the thrilling second half and lost to Carthage, 55-52.

**Final Rites Held Tuesday For Mrs. Nettie Reynolds**

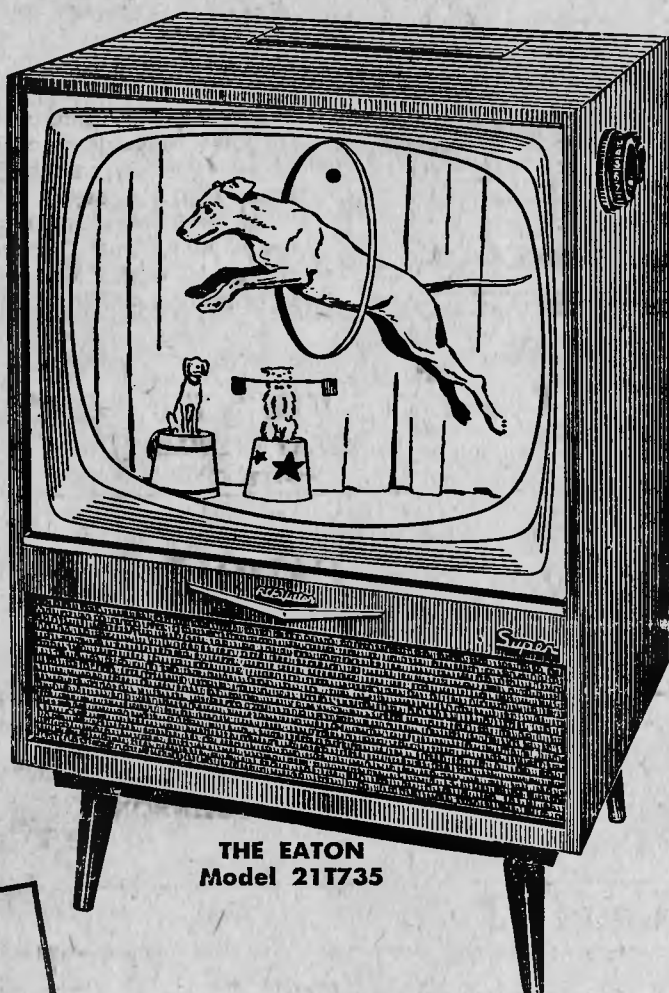
