She is taking her recruit training at Bainbridge, Md., along with 70 other young women from throughout the United States. Hoping for selection to take hospital training, she first must go through basic training. Later, if selected, she will be stationed at Bainbridge and will later receive an assignment at one of the naval hospitals.

A 1956 graduate of Southern Pines High School, she was active in the dramatic and glee clubs and later attended Pfeiffer College in Misenheimer.

Mr. Blackmon, former police chief in Charlotte, was a chief shore patrolman with the Navy for five years during World War 2.

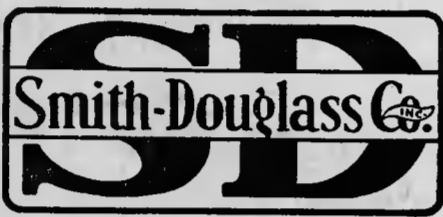

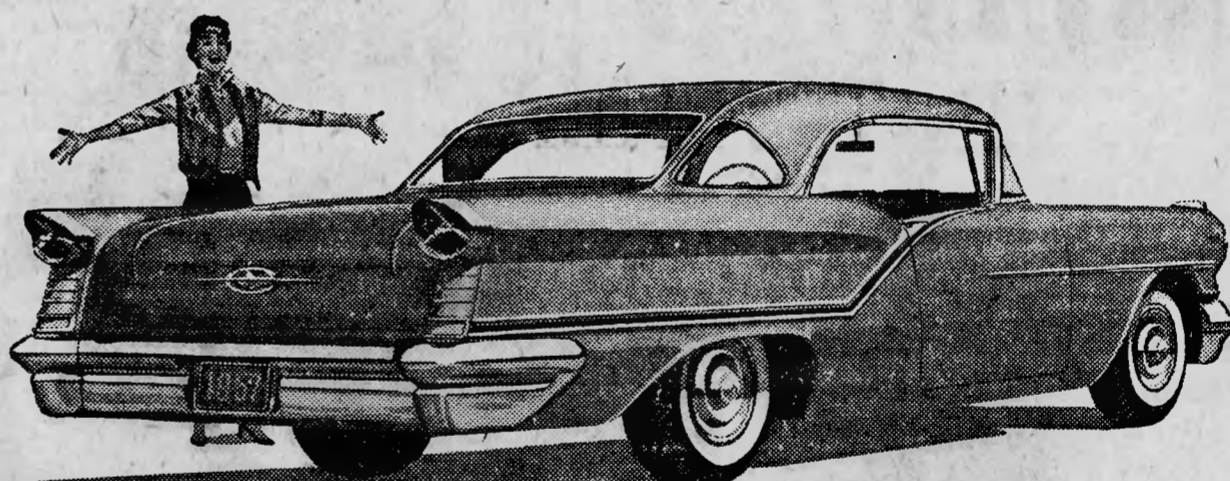

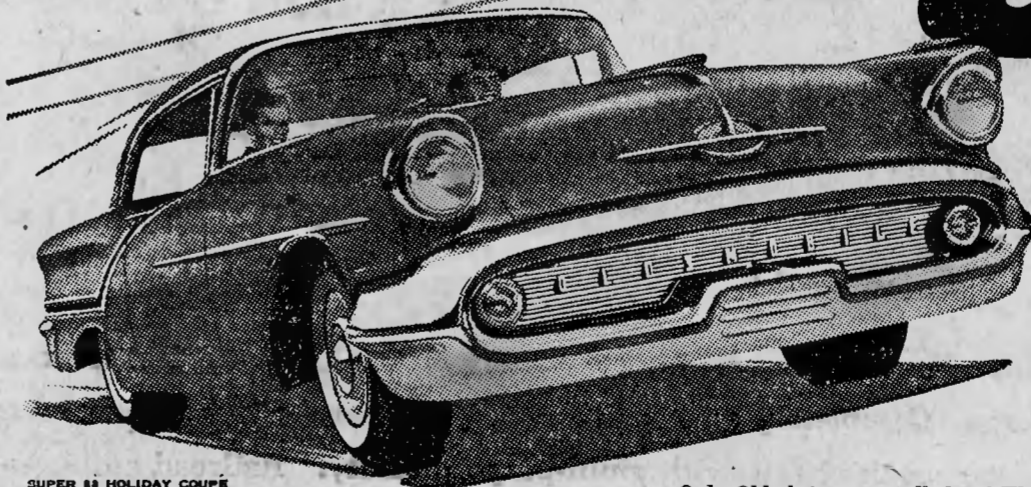
