SEES INDUSTRIAL EXPANSION

Citizens Bank Becomes Member of Business Development Corporation

The Citizens Bank and Trust Company of Southern Pines has been accepted as a member of the Business Development Corporation of North Carolina, according to an announcement made this week by Norris L. Hodgkins, the bank's president.

The Business Development Corporation was authorized by the 1955 General Assembly. Under the terms of the Enabling Act it operates under, financial institutions in the state are permitted; through membership, to share in the program of the corporation for the sound development—primarily through industry—of North Carolina.

Hodgkins said that the interest

which has recently been shown in industrial development of Moore County was instrumental in the decision of the bank's directors to join with many other North Carolina banks and financial institutions in becoming a member.

Governor Hodges originally initiated the thinking behind the Business Development Corporation. Primarily, it is an agency that loans money to new or expanding industry. The members make funds available to the corporation, which in turn loans the funds to the new industry.

The program has been termed a tremendous force in helping to locate so-called "home industry," as well as helping industry from other states to relocate in North Carolina.

Monk Womack To Head County Little League This Year

Monk Womack of Carthage has been elected president of the Moore County Little League for 1957 succeeding Dr. J. C. Grier of Pinehurst.

Womack said an 18-game schedule has been drawn up for the season which begins the last week in May. Four teams, the same as were entered last year, will compete: Carthage, Southern Pines, Robbins and Pinehurst.

Last year Southern Pines was county champion with one of the finest teams that Coach C. L. Dutton has had in his many years in the league.

The Moore County all-stars, composed of members from each of the four teams, also gained state-wide recognition by advancing to the semi-finals in state playoffs. Other officers elected to serve with Womack are James Steed of Robbins, vice-president; Dr. Delmar Mann of Southern Pines, secretary; and Harris Blake of Pinehurst, treasurer.

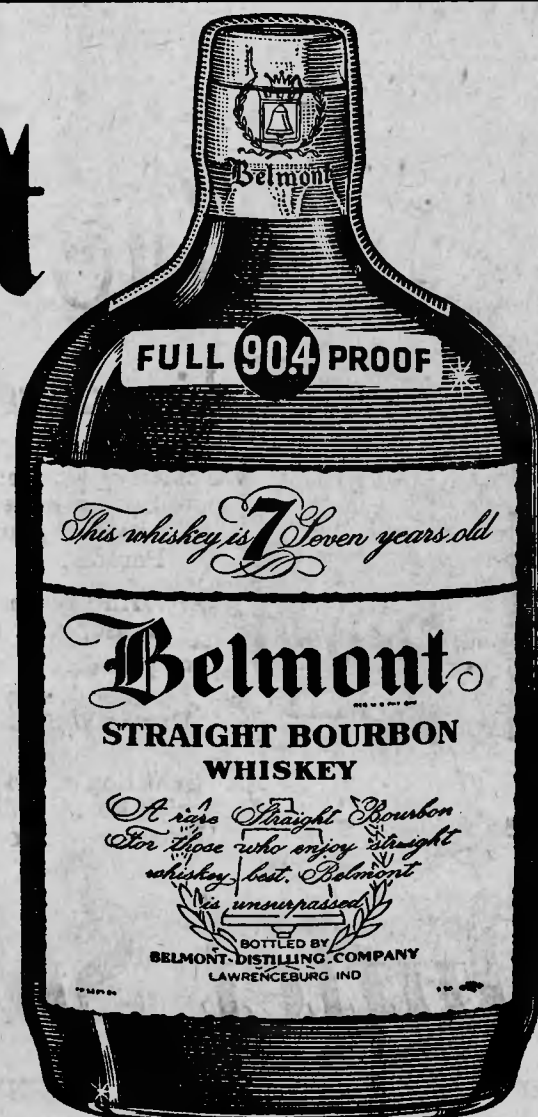
