The above regulation was adopted by the School Board at its regular meeting on April 3, 1957.

Action Against Three Charged In West End Beating Taken In Court

On Solicitor W. Lamont Brown's recommendation, a nol pros was taken in Moore recorders court Monday in the case against Mrs. Ottis Lemmons, nol pros with leave in the case against her husband Ottis, and a capias was ordered to issue for her brother, Lester Lee Parks, with subpoena for all witnesses to appear Monday, May 6.
All the defendants, listed as from Montgomery county, had been charged with assault with deadly weapon with intent to kill, inflicting serious and permanent injury, in the near-fatal beating of Hal McKinnon, elderly furniture worker of West End, last October 24.
However, Solicitor Brown pointed out to Judge Rowe, while trial was pending Lemmons had shot his wife to death at their home, and is now in prison serving a long term for her murder. Parks, brother of the late Mrs. Lemmons, had been left to bear the assault charges alone.
Following the beating, the case could not come immediately into court. Driving at excessive speed back to Montgomery county, the trio had been in a wreck and Lemmons had landed in Montgomery Memorial hospital with broken ribs and punctured lung. Considered in too bad shape to make an escape, he was not guarded in the hospital and disappeared from there, to be gone several weeks. When finally apprehended, and he and his wife came into court—the man's body still in a cast—no trial could be held as McKinnon had still not recovered sufficiently to appear. The State continued the case, the Lemmons left and that afternoon the shooting occurred at their home.
T. Eldridge Short, 54, of Route 4, Carthage, was placed under

a four-months sentence suspended for two years, or pay a \$400 fine including costs, on conviction of possessing sixteen and a half gallons of illicit whiskey for sale.
Other cases disposed of:
Bobby Needham, Robbins, speeding 85, careless and reckless driving, 60 days on roads, or \$75 and costs, license revoked as provided by law.
Cecil Smith, Route 1, Seagrove, careless and reckless driving, \$25 and costs.
Farrell Reece Chriscoe, Route 2, Seagrove, careless and reckless driving, accident, property damage and injury, 60 days or \$25 and costs, ordered to pay or cause payment of hospital and other medical expenses of the two accident victims who were riding with him in his car, defendant noted appeal and bond was set at \$300.
Ollie McLeod, Southern Pines, assault with deadly weapon (pistol), six months in Women's Division of States Prison.
Daniel LaVerne McCaskill, Carthage, driving without license, \$25 including costs.
Ardenia Matherson Spencer, Eagle Springs, driving without registration card, no license, judgment continued on payment of \$25 including costs.
Thomas Carter Jackson, Jr., Carthage, careless and reckless driving, accident, driving drunk, 90 days or \$100 and costs, license revoked 12 months.
Roy Furr, Jr., larceny of clothing valued at less than \$100, capias and sci fa.
Ed Worthy, Carthage, trespass, assault and battery on female, drunk and disorderly, cursing, threats, not guilty.
Jerry Wesley Blake, Troy, abandonment and failure to support, three months or pay costs and \$200 to wife (may be paid in

\$25 monthly instalments).
Phil Moore Oliver, Sanford, unlawful possession, capias and sci fa.
Albert Franklin Phillips, Southern Pines, assault with deadly weapon on wife, assault and battery, threats, judgment continued on payment of \$25 including costs, on conditions of good behavior toward wife during next two years (wide did not wish to prosecute).
Arthur C. Clark, Greenville, S. C., drunk driving, 60 days or \$100 and costs, license revoked 12 months.
Everette Brewer, assault on

wife, sci fa on bondsman.
Capias and sci fa were ordered in cases against Henry Lomax Bost, Concord, speeding 54 (tractor-trailer); Edgar Gilchrist, Jr., Sanford, speeding 65, and Cordell Parks, careless and reckless driving. Capias was ordered to issue for Willie Shade Hendrix for failure to comply.
