WITH THE Armed Forces

Staff Sergeant James W. Dupree, West End, of the 500th Bombardment, at Langley AFB, was selected as a member of the Ninth Air Force's composite air strike force now participating in "Exercise Carib-ex" in the Panama Canal Zone.

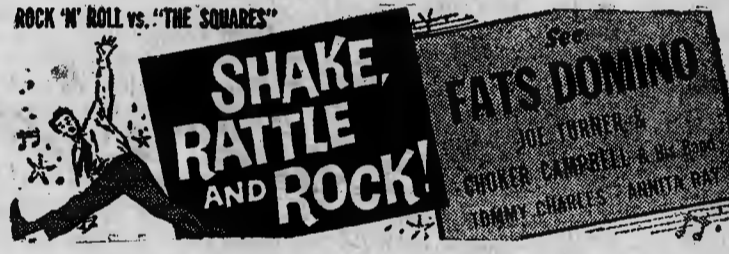
