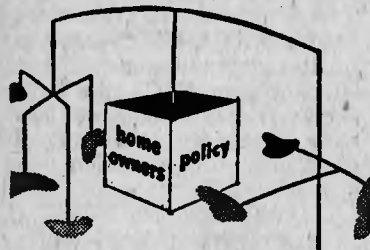
Circles Meet

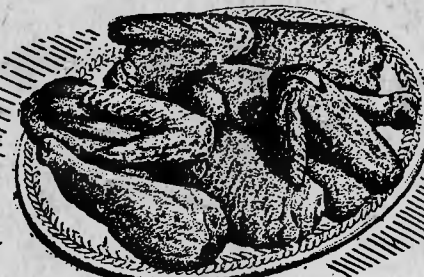
