DR. CAMERON TO SPEAK

UNC Alumni to Hear About Honors Student Program at Oct. 12 Meet

University of North Carolina alumni of Moore County will hear first-hand about the nationally significant Honors Student Program at Chapel Hill, in development of which a Moore County native, Dr. Ed A. Cameron, has taken a leading role. Dr. Cameron, chairman of the University Committee on Superior students and professor of mathematics, will be a guest and speaker at a meeting of UNC alumni, to be held October 12 at the Howard Johnson's Restaurant between Southern Pines and Aberdeen.

Another guest and speaker will be Dr. Charles Henderson, advisor to honors students in the University's General College.

Paul C. Butler and Voit Gilmore, president of Moore County alumni and program chairman, respectively, announced the meeting today. Invitations have been sent to all Carolina alumni in the county. The evening is Dutch treat, \$3 per person covering social hour and meal.

Two Moore County students, now in residence at Chapel Hill, are members of the select Honors group. Willis Williams of Robbins, a Morehead Scholar selected from Moore County a year ago, is beginning his second year at Chapel Hill as an honors student. John C. Currie, son of Wilbur Currie of Carthage, also is a member of the Honors Program and was selected as a Morehead Scholar from Christ School last spring. He is a freshman at the

University. Dr. Cameron, a native of Manly, has been a member of the faculty at Chapel Hill for 30 years. He was graduated in 1928, later taking graduate work and in 1936 received his Ph. D. in mathematics. Dr. Henderson is a graduate of Davidson College in 1942, took graduate work and his Ph. D. at Chapel Hill in classics, joining the faculty in 1955. He was recently named adviser of the special group of 50 superior students in this fall's entering freshman class.

Phase C, East Southern Pines High School, Southern Pines, N. C.

Plans and specifications will be on file at the office of the Board in Southern Pines, N. C., in the plan rooms of F. W. Dodge Corp., Charlotte, Durham, and Greensboro; and in the Associated General Contractors plan rooms in Charlotte, Raleigh and Greensboro. One copy of plans and specifications may be obtained by licensed contractors upon written request to Leslie N. Boney, Architect, P. O. Box 986, Wilmington, N. C., accompanied by a certified check for \$50.00 made as a deposit. All of said deposit will be refunded to bona fide bidders upon return of plans and specifications to the architect.

Each bidders proposal must be accompanied by a bid bond of at least 5% of the amount of his bid, or in lieu thereof he may present a certified check made payable to Mr. N. L.
