

Warning Issued on Fort Bragg Danger

Fort Bragg officials have issued a warning to all personnel to stay off Fort Bragg firing ranges unless they have official business there. Ranges are in daily use at

Bragg and hazards exist due to artillery, small arms firing and unexploded ammunition on these ranges.

The two primary danger areas are: The northeast portion of the reservation, east of Highway No. 210, bounded by the post boundary on the north, McCormick

Bridge Road on the east, Honeycutt Road on the south and the post boundary on the west.

That portion of the reservation bounded on the east by Gruber Road, on the north by Manchester Road, on the south by Plank Road, and on the west by King Road.

Entering into these areas, unless on official business, is prohibited.
