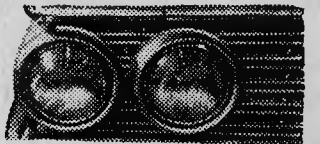
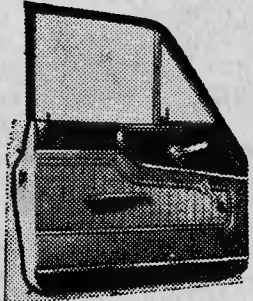
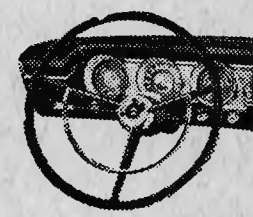
Two new vacation publications are just off the press for use in 1962 travel shows by the State Advertising Division. They are

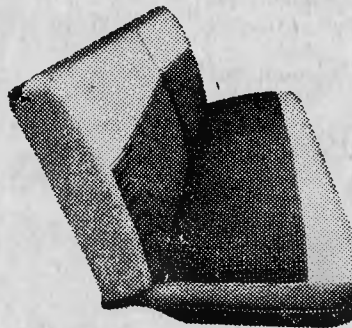
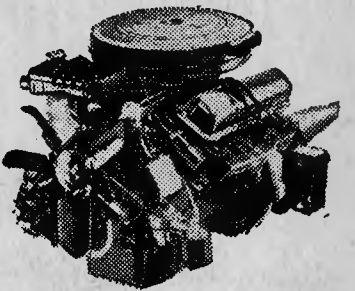

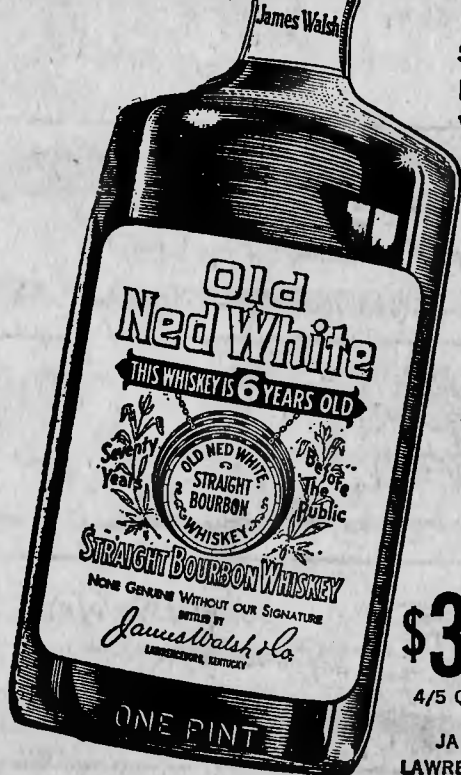
