### Discount Tobacco Program Will Be Continued In '64

The flue-cured tobacco discount variety programs will be continued in effect for the 1964 crop, A. P. Hassell, Jr., executive director for the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation State Committee, reminds tobacco growers.

Under this program, price supports for discount varieties are one-half the support rates of comparable grades of acceptable varieties. The discount varieties include Coker 139, Coker 140, Coker 316, Reams 64, and Dixie Bright 244. Any mixture or strain of these seed varieties, or any breeding line of flue-cured varieties, including 187 Golden Wilt, also resigned as No Name, XYZ, having the quality and chemical characteristics of the five varieties, will be designed as discount varieties.

Mr. Hassell urged every grower to obtain his tobacco seed from reliable sources. By doing this, he will be protected against the planting of mixed or inferior seed.

As in past years, tobacco will be checked while it is growing in the field. Any tobacco having growth characteristics and chemical properties similar to a discount variety will be supported at one-half the support rate for acceptable varieties.

So it is most important that each farmer be sure of the variety of tobacco he plants.
