Brush Burning Permits Must Now Be Obtained; Where To Get Them Told

Travis A. Wicker, Moore County forest ranger, announced this week that the brush burning permit season for Moore County and North Carolina begins October 1 and will continue until June 1.

During that period it is unlawful to start a fire outdoors more than 100 feet from an occupied dwelling house or within 500 feet of a State-protected forest area during the hours from midnight to 4 p. m., without first getting a permit from a fire warden or his deputy. The State and Federal fire prevention organization is set up to assist the public and to help control fires, as well as to prevent the burning of woodlands and the destruction of timber, he reminded.

Complete Law Quoted

The law governing fires reads as follows:

"G.S. 14-139. Starting fires within five hundred feet of areas under protection of State Forestry Service. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to start or cause to be started any fire or ignite any material in any of the areas of woodlands under the protection of the State Forest Service or within five hundred (500) feet of any such protected area, during the hours starting at midnight and ending at 4 p. m., without first obtaining from the State Forester or one of his duly authorized agents a permit to start or cause to be started any fire or ignite any material in such above mentioned protected areas; the provisions of this Act to be in force during the period between the first day of October and the first day of June inclusive. forest fire conditions the State Forester is authorized to cancel all permits and prohibit the starting of any fires in any of the woodlands under the protection of the State Forest Service or within five hundred (500) feet of any such protected area.

"This section shall not apply to any fires started or caused to be started within one hundred (100) feet of any occupied dwelling house.

"Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Act shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) or imprisoned for a period of not more than (30) days."
