PRESIDENT'S EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT AND CERTIFICATE IN MAKING EFFECTIVE THE WORKING CODE OF THE

NATIONAL RECOVERY ADMINISTRATION

ALL STORES AT A SPECIAL MEETING HELD MONDAY, JULY 31, AGREED TO ADOPT THE BLANKET RECOVERY CODE AND THE FOLLOWING HOURS FOR OPENING AND CLOSING OF STORES WILL BE OBSERVED, EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1ST—

WEEK DAYS
 Open 8 O'clock
 Close 6 O'clock

SATURDAYS
 Open 8 O'clock
 Close 9:30 O'clock

DURING THESE HOURS, EMPLOYEES WILL WORK EIGHT HOURS DAILY OR ON A BASIS OF 48 HOURS EACH WEEK. THE STORE PROPRIETORS OR MANAGERS WILL OPEN AND CLOSE THEIR PLACES OF BUSINESS, BUT CLERKS OR EMPLOYEES WILL WORK IN SHIFTS OF EIGHT HOURS DAILY.
