

Many Attend Special Services At Colored Church Here Sunday

Interesting Program Was Enjoyed On Second Annual Teachers Day

Sunday, November 17, 1940, was a very important and interesting day at the Mount Shiloh Colored Baptist Church. It was the second annual Teachers' Day and was attended by all the teachers of the Negro race in the county.

At 9:30 o'clock Sunday morning, the church school was held with N. W. Slade, of the Robersonville schools, acting as superintendent. All official and teaching positions were turned over to the teachers of the county schools. Following the Sunday school, R. G. Gaither delivered a special address. Other talks were made by Don Chance, J. A. Holley, Ruth Downing, Rebecca Everett and Fannie Slade.

Rev. L. T. Bond, pastor of the church, delivered the regular 11 o'clock sermon. He was followed by Mary Gray, supervisor of the Martin County Negro schools.

At 2:30 p. m., Rev. J. A. S. Cole, pastor of the Williamston Chapel Zion Church, spoke on "Build on the Solid Rock."

The final service of the day began at 7:30 p. m., in what was said to be a fitting climax to the second annual teachers' day. Music was furnished by two groups of singers, both being composed of members of the WPA organization of Williamston. The principal addresses of the evening were made by E. S. Peel, local attorney, and J. C. Manning, county superintendent of schools.

The address of Mr. Peel definitely appealed to the spiritual as well as the civic in his discourse to the teachers. He spoke of democracy as it af-
