Report Your 1941 Crop Acreage Through Your Local List-Taker During January, 1942	There is a Town Ordinance requiring all owners of Automobiles and Trucks in the Town of Williamston to display a town license plate on said cars and	See Us For The Right Price And The Best Fertilizer Product
Your local Tax Lister is required to make the records, but farm owners or tenants must furnish the facts. Therefore, call your list-taker's attention to these records and be prepared to furnish the following information: (1) Acreage for each crop harvested during calendar year 1941; (2) Number of horses, mules, cows, sows, ewes and hens on farm January, 1942; (3) Number of people living on farm January, 1942; (4) Number of threshing machines, com- bines, peanut pickers, farm tractors and farm trucks. All of the above information furnished will be considered as confidential, and will not be used in any manner that is detrimental to the farmers concerned. It is not used for tax purposes.
