- Price Ceilings Will Get More Numerous
- On the domestic battlefield — where a war is being fought against that constant companion of Mars, Old Man High Cost of Living—the campaign now is moving rapidly into the "frontal attack" phase. That is, the OPA is swinging more and more into action on retail price control and rationing, instead of the "rear guard" or "delaying actions" it has employed in months past. Price ceilings will get more and more numerous, and will be applied more directly to retail prices of articles, rather than to wholesale ones on materials and commodities. Action on basic cost-of-living influencers like food, clothing and rentals will be stressed first. It's hard to anticipate the specific steps, but the wise thing for Mr. and Mrs. John Q. Public to do is keep eyes and ears open for all developments in the price line—up or down—and shop thriftily and intelligently. For instance, there's definite news on new regulations about installment buying. Starting March 23rd the time periods allowed will be shorter, down payments must be larger, and seven new items come under this regulation.
