The tragedy o fthe Somme seems near its climax, says a semi-official dispatch from Berlin just received this afternoon. It is becoming more and more apparent, from the viewpoint of the German capital, that the French and English will "bleed to death on the unshakable German front, just as the Russians did in Galicia."

WOULD MAKE ROUMANIA SEC-OND SERBIA

What is believed to be the beginning of Von Hindenberg's widely heralded campaign to crush Serbia has been launched in the great new Teuton offensive near the north western frontier of Roumania.

Alming to drive a wedge between the Russian and Roumanian armies strong Teutonic forces are attacking the Russian front south of Bukowing and near the junction of the two armies.

The German war office announces that the Russians have been driven back at th's point. The Roumanlans ane also falling back along their own frontier. Southwest of Kronstadt the Teutons are attacking in great force and heavy fighting is in progress on Roumanian 8011.

The situation in Dobrudja is unchanged according to official statements from the capital of all the 1 92.99 warring nations.
