The last time he was arrested and sentenced to jail. The day after Jandro's arrest, two weeks ago, his little boy be-came ill. Jandro, unable to go to its bedside, was almost insane with worry and grief. Sunday, the little boy died. He was buried Tuesday. The cross of punishment which the law laid upon Jandro was an adamant refusal to let him leave the jail long enough to attend his child's funeral. The sheriff said he had only recently been threat-ened with indictment for an al-most similar act of humanitarian-ism.




