

# Elizabeth City Hands Hertford Second Shutout

## SAFFELLE HURLS THREE HIT GAME

Team Mates Hammer Bryant Mightily, Grimes Getting Homer; Smith and Bloxom 2 Doubles Each

Skipper Bob Saffelle demonstrated clearly and to the satisfaction of everybody concerned that he was not only thoroughly at home on first base, but that he could pitch, as well, by holding Hertford to three widely separated hits for a 6 to 0 victory, in a game that was marked by exceedingly free hitting by his team mates.

For instance, Grimes accounted for a homer over the favored right field fence. Smith and Bloxom gathered in a couple of two-baggers apiece. Catcher "Shorty" Clifford outdid himself to the tune of three singles, and Saffelle, a little forgetful at times at bat, he was pitching, and wasn't fully expected to hit, annexed three safeties for himself.

Saffelle was not imperilled except in the sixth inning. With Thompson out on a Texas leaguer to Grimes, Lindley walked and pitcher Bryant rapped out a double, putting Lindley on third ahead of him. At that time, Elizabeth City only had two runs, and it looked much as though Hertford might be the count—if not worse. Fogleman, however, was out. Bloxom to Grimes, and Saffelle pulled himself cleanly out of the hole by fanning Underwood.

Elizabeth City plays in Edenton today, while Hertford closes the week in Colerain.

In yesterday's game, there were two hits of clever fielding well worthy of mention. One was in the ninth inning, when Clifford raced over to the left field bleachers to gather in a pop foul by Underwood. The other was the all-around work of Grimes, that nifty second baseman handling ten chances without an error.

## BERLENBACH LOSES TITLE TO DELANEY

New York, July 17.—Jack Delaney took the light heavyweight championship of the world last night from Paul Berlenbach in a crashing, smashing finish that swept his foe before him in the last five rounds.

The French-Canadian challenger from Bridgeport, Connecticut, lifted the title with a victory that was as spectacular as it was decisive. He carried off the unanimous verdict of the referee and judges, besides being given a wide margin on points by the big majority of ringside critics.

A capacity crowd of 45,000 paid approximately \$175,000 to witness the spectacle. They hailed the new champion with a terrific ovation.
