QLASS AS PAVING BLOCKS.

Not Affected by Extreme Cold, Fric-

tion or Blows. At the request of the secretary of commerce and labor, the department of state at Washington collected information concerning the use of paving blocks and building brick made of glass. Paying blocks of this character are used in France. Old glass obtained from broken bottles, window panes and the like is used in the manufacture of these bricks and tiles. Tests carried out in Paris showed that a certain make of this artificial stone resisted a pressure of 28,774 pounds to the square inch, while granite stood a pressure of only 9,245 pounds.

Gas and Electricity.
