PRESIDENT TAKES INEVITABLE STEP

ASKS AUTHORITY TO ARM MERCHANTMEN AND OTHER NECESSARY MEASURES.

FOR AN ARMED NEUTRALITY

Immediate Response Was Introduction in House of Bill Empowering President to Furnish Merchantment With Guns and Gunners.

Washington. - President Wilson took the inevitable step and asked Congress for authority to use the forces of the United States to protect American ships and lives against the German submarine menace - to put the Nation in a state of armed neutrality.

The immediate response was the introduction in the House of a bill empowering him to furnish guns and gunners to American merchantmen, to employ such other instrumentalities and methods as may become necessary, and providing for a \$100,000,000 bond issue to be used in his discretion for war insurance to encourage American commerce to brave the submarine peril.

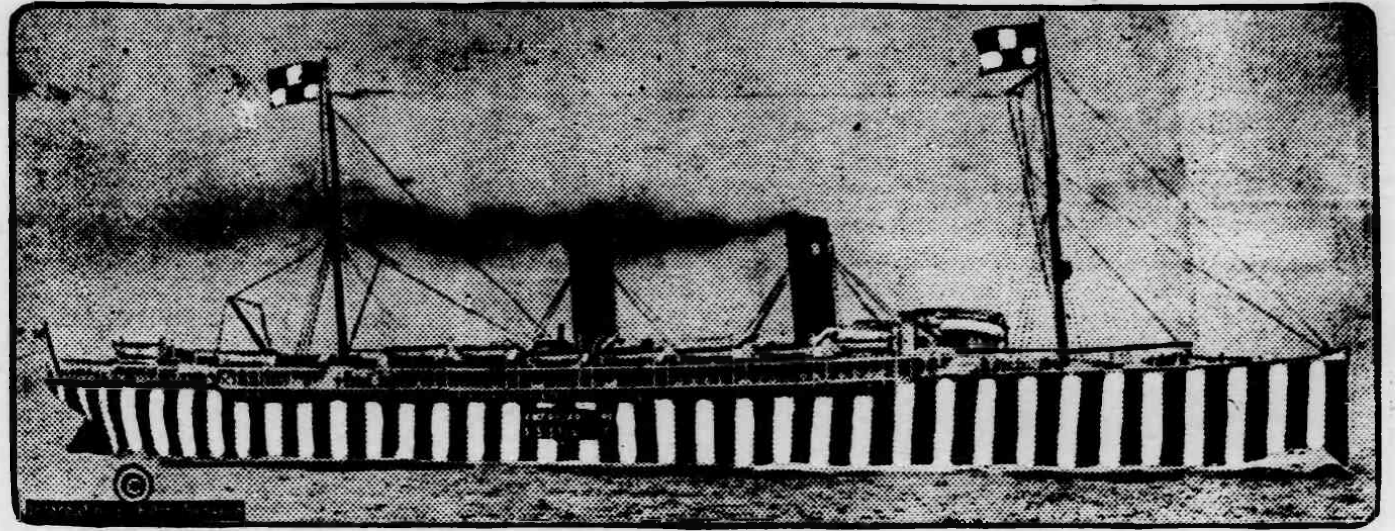

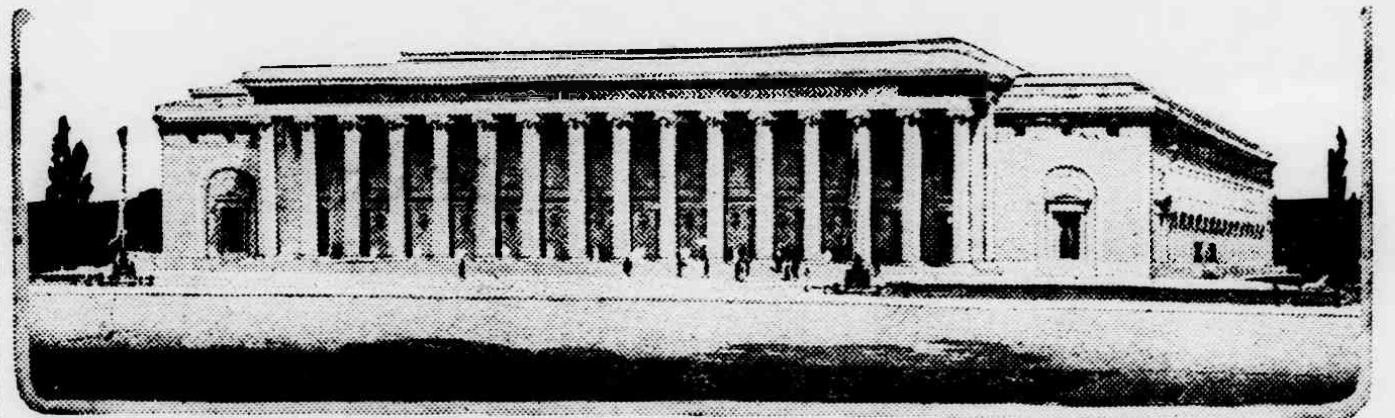
