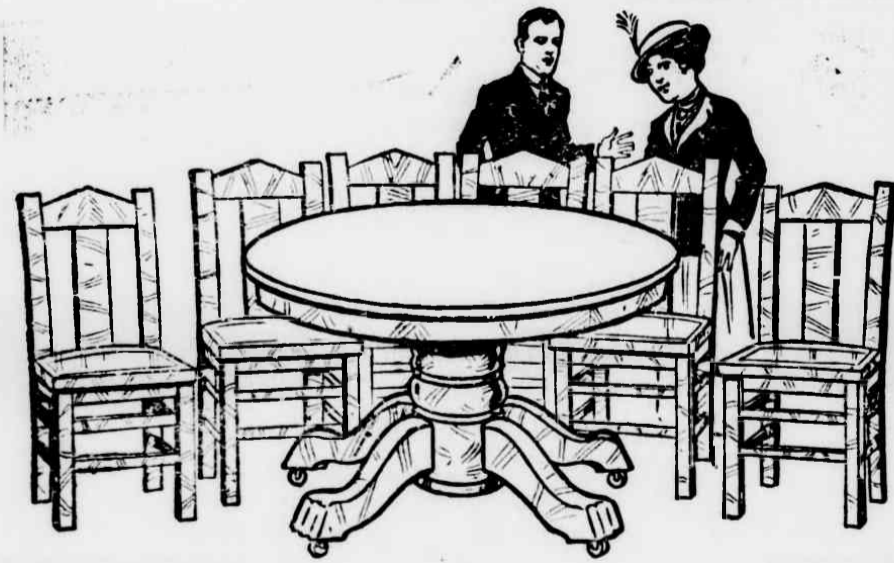

It was also stated that nearly half the 110 automobile makers in the chamber do not fit muffler cut-outs on their present cars.

THANKS FOR POTATOES

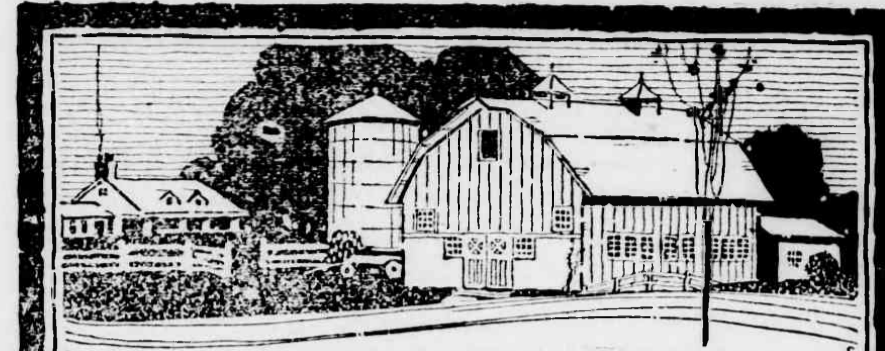
