Office of the Board of County Commissioners of Transylvania County, N. C., April 1, 1918. Order for an Election on Bond Issue—Roads.

One hundred free-holders of Transylvania County, North Carolina, having petitioned the undersigned under and by virtue of Chapter 284 of the Public Laws of the State of North Carolina for the year 1917, for an election in said county of Transylvania, for a bond issue in the sum of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) Dollars, for the purpose of laying out and opening, altering and repairing the public road or highway from the Henderson County line, by way of Brevard, North Carolina, to Rosman, North Carolina, a distance of approximately twenty-one miles, said road or highway to be definitely surveyed or located under the direction of the State Highway Commission of the State of North Carolina, and said petition having heretofore been presented to said State Highway Commission and approved by it as provided in said Act, said election to take the sense of the qualified voters of said County of Transylvania on the question of whether the Board of County Commissioners of Transylvania County shall issue bonds for such purpose.

It is therefore, under and by virtue of Chapter 284 of the Public Laws of North Carolina for the year 1917, ordered by the Board of County Commissioners of Transylvania County, that an election be held for said county, on Wednesday, May 15th, 1918, to take the sense of the qualified voters of said County of Transylvania on the question of whether the Board of County Commissioners of Transylvania County, North Carolina, shall issue bonds in the sum of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) Dollars, for the purpose of laying out and opening, altering and repairing the public road or highway from the Henderson County line, by way of Brevard, North Carolina, to the town of Rosman, North Carolina, a distance of approximately twenty-one miles, said road or highway to be definitely surveyed or located under the direction of the State Highway Commission of the State of North Carolina.

It is further ordered by the Board that a new registration for said bond election be had, and the same is hereby ordered, to be as near as may be in conformity to the laws governing the registration of voters, and in strict conformity to the Act hereinbefore mentioned and set out, and the following named persons are hereby appointed registrars for said bond election, viz:

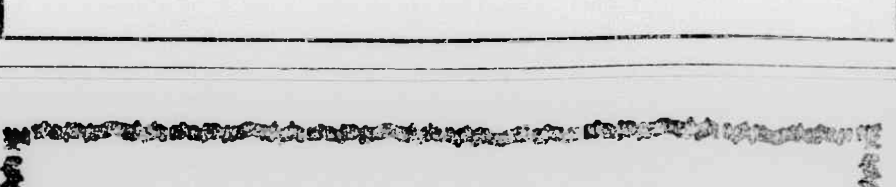
