TIME TO START BIG CLEAN UP CRUSADE

National Bureau Is Helping Thousands of Communities Push the Attack.

READY FOR THE ONSLAUGHT

Headquarters of Great Organization, in Operation Five Years, Promotes Cleanliness, Comeliness, Cheeriness and Conservation.

"Clean up and paint up!" Don't you hear the call? Indoors and outdoors. Work for each and all! Clean house—and paint house. White or brown or red; Tidy up the back yard. And paint up the shed; Burn the alley rubbish; Send the tin can hence. After that—the thought is rich!—Fix that alley fence!

"Clean Up and Paint Up the National Capital!" shouted a Washington newspaper in type that was spread all over the top of a page, just a few days after Congress accepted Germany's gage of war. "Washington begins its spring cleaning and painting campaign," added the same journal, in type somewhat more subdued in tone. All Washington heard the call and heeded. It was the national capital's call to arms. Everybody volunteered. There was no age limit in either direction. Nobody was rejected because of defective teeth, ingrowing toe-nails, strabismus or housemaid's knee. The big army mobilized overnight. It armed itself—broomsticks in hand, brushes ditto, scrub-cloths, soap, water, rakes, paint cans and buckets!

No Lack of Preparedness.

Washington did not get its orders from the White House or from the big building under the gilded dome at the top of Pennsylvania avenue. The nation's capital took its cue for this campaign from a middle Western city—St. Louis, headquarters of the National Clean Up and Paint Up Campaign bureau. There was no lack of preparedness, for the bureau had been in operation five years. It was simply a call to mobilization. A similar mobilization of local forces is taking place right now in thousands of other communities throughout the land—to promote cleanliness, comeliness, cheeriness and conservation.

This American national campaign is an annual affair. It may be called perennial, for somewhere it is going on all the time. According to climate, weather, local conditions it is controlled and carried on. It is a modern crusade, Hometown being the Holy City and every good citizen being a Richard Coeur de Leon, a lion-hearted knight armed cap-a-pie with a rake and paintbrush, mop and varnish can.

There Are Many Advantages.

Through this nation-wide movement health is being conserved, the sick list is being shortened, the death rate is being lowered. Through it the owners of city and town property are getting lower rates of insurance, for it is a fire-prevention propaganda as well as a crusade against dirt and disease. Property values are increased by this salutary work. Dwellings and apartments and flats which are made and kept clean and varnished and painted to spick-and-span effect sell or rent more readily than when left untidy and going to wrack and ruin.

The cleanest town in the world is the best town to live in. Best because it is the healthiest. Best because it has the fewest fires. Best because it is the most beautiful.
