

TOXAWAY COMMUNITY FAIR

To be Held

October the 11th 1919

1. All agricultural, horticultural, home economics, and fancy work exhibits should be placed and arranged as far as possible on Oct. 10th and not later than 10 o'clock on the 11th, date of fair.

2. All live stock must be on the grounds with entrance tags attached not later than ten o'clock on date of the fair.

3. All exhibits entered for prizes must be from South or West of Brevard and from Transylvania County.

4. No exhibits will be awarded more than one prize.

5. Entrance tags with detachable coupons will be furnished for all exhibits.

6. Premiums will be designated by ribbons, Blue meaning first prize, red second prize, white, third prize.

7. Premiums will be paid Nov. 15 except special premiums, which will be on exhibit, and will be awarded on day of fair.

8. Registration papers must be exhibited with registered stock.

9. Ribbons must not be taken off of any exhibits until after four o'clock on date of fair.

10. All exhibits must stay as they are placed until four o'clock or no premiums will be paid on those taken away.
