

THE COAL RESTRICTIONS

The Regional Coal Committee of the Fuel Administration, with headquarters at Atlanta, came to the conclusion that there was no prospect of immediate relief of the disquieting coal shortage from the men who dig coal. From many quarters within the

territorial jurisdiction of the committee came distress calls for coal with winter days threatening them every hour. Drastic action seemed immediately necessary and so drastic action was taken.

All places of business with a very few exceptions will open at 9 a. m. and close at 4 p. m.

Generally, drug stores, hospitals, hotels, restaurants, depots, newspaper establishments, public utilities and essential industries are excepted from the new order, though the administration warns that unless there is a rapid clearing up of the coal situation, further drastic steps by way of curtailment will be taken.

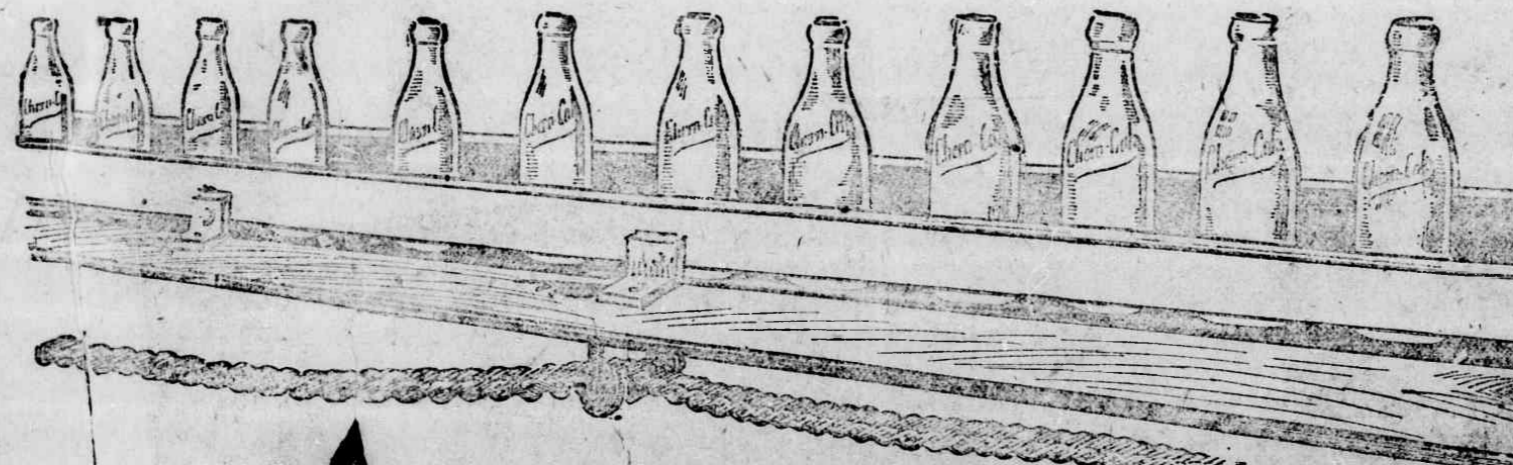
