

FEDERAL COURT STARTS NOV. 14

Because of the creation of a new federal court district in North Carolina, the annual fall term of court, which was formerly held in Asheville, will begin this year on the second Monday, Nov. 14, it has been announced by T. J. Harkins, district attorney.

Because of the large number of cases in the docket, the court will extend over a two weeks period instead of one as formerly.

The following arrangement for trial of cases by counties has been arranged and will be adhered to during the term:

Lincolnton and McDowell counties, Nov. 14, 15, 16.

Watauga, Mitchell and Yancey counties, Nov. 17.

Cherokee and Graham counties, Nov. 18.

Swain and Macon counties, Nov. 21.

Blount and Haywood counties, Nov. 22.

Transylvania, Henderson, Polk and Rutherford, Nov. 24 and 25.

The grand jury will convene Monday morning, Nov. 14, and all witnesses subpoenaed for the grand jury should report on that day regardless of the county from which they come, it was announced.
