Polluted rivers mean perils to public health, retards continued industrial development, damage to if not extinction of fish life, and generally unpleasant conditions. Tackling of the problem in North Carolina before conditions reach the proportions exper-ienced in some other states, will focus the attention of the authori-ties and the factors involved upon preventive measures, and more than likely the most effective and farreaching part of the duties of the committee will be in checking the spread of tainted surface waters.
