In Handling Gasoline Rationing Coupons Always - -

- 1. Always ask for Rationing Book before delivering gasoline.
- 2. Always be sure correct Ration Sticker is properly displayed on the vehicle.
- 3. Always be sure the vehicle is the same as described on the Ration Book cover.
- 4. Always detach Coupons from the book.
- 5. Always see that Coupons are endorsed as follows: A, B, C, D, and T Coupons (except those issued to fleets) Must Show On Front Of Coupons.
 - (1) Vehicle number and State of Registration.
 - B, C, D and T Coupons issued to fleets Must Show On Front Of Coupons.
 - (1) Name and address of fleet operator showing State and Town (or)
 - (2) Certificate of War Necessity number and State and Town (or)
- (3) License number of vehicle and State.
- E Coupons Must Show On Front.
 - (1) Name and address of Ration holder plain written.
